2010 Leadership Award**

This award will be given out to recognize both the Manager and the Community for a particularly bold and innovative project or for solving an unusually difficult problem. Examples could include Downtown revitalization projects, new and innovative ways of providing everyday services such as waste disposal, public safety services and over the counter services, innovative uses of zoning and other land use controls, helping to bring peace to a Community after a particularly divisive issue or finding a solution to a difficult financial problem. Essentially any project or effort that benefits a community or group of communities would be eligible for this award. The Manager receiving the award must have played a key role in developing the project as well as implementing it. The recipient can be self nominated or be nominated by his or her peers, staff, citizens or elected officials. The recipient must be an MTCMA member.
